



Tadorne is a thriving new community being created by Croudace Homes in Tadworth, Surrey. The story:

In 2015, leading house-builder Croudace Homes enlisted the services of Power-Pipe's innovative Waste Water Heat Recovery Systems (WWHRS) at Tadorne, and Architectural Technologist, Paul Davis, explains why:

"Initially we had looked at installing a competitor product in our Tadorne homes but soon encountered a problem. We realised that the system originally specified would not be suitable because it was 50mm diameter.

"This meant it would have to run alongside the Soil Ventilation Pipe (SVP), so the size of the SVP boxing would need to be increased to accommodate.

"This wasn't an option for us because the WWHRS needed to go via an en-suite, which had fitted furniture around it, so there was insufficient room to make the boxing any bigger.

"Power-Pipe provided the ideal solution. It is the only Waste Water Heat Recovery System which is available in a 110mm diameter, so it is fitted in line with the SVP with no need to increase the size of the boxing. It also gave us the necessary SAP uplift we needed to pass building regulations and was very cost-effective."
